


# COMMON SYMPTOMS STEROIDS

## HYPERACTIVITY/MOOD SWINGS:

APPEARANCE: aggression, restlessness, anxiety.



## ADRENAL GLANDS:

APPEARANCE: skin lesions, hair loss, scabs, weight gain, fatigue, muscle pain.

BEHAVIOR: chewing, scratching, rubbing, lethargy.

## PANTING:

APPEARANCE: increase in thirst, appears to be in pain and/or have a hard time catching breath.

BEHAVIOR: drinking more, anxious, frequent urination.

#### **DIABETES:**

APPEARANCE: increase in thirst and appetite.

BEHAVIOR: lethargy, increase in appetite, laziness, drinking and urinating more, weight gain.

#### PANCREAS:

APPEARANCE: painful abdomen, abdominal distention, lack of appetite, dehydration.

BEHAVIOR: vomiting, diarrhea, hunched up posture, lethargy.

## DIARRHEA:

APPEARANCE: pot belly, sagging stomach, loose stool.

BEHAVIOR: Increase in appetite, difficulty walking long distances & raising itself after lying down.

### WEIGHT GAIN:

APPEARANCE: pot belly, sagging stomach.

BEHAVIOR: increase in appetite, difficulty walking long distances & raising itself after lying down.
